- is not a SC High School Diploma.
- is not for all students with disabilities.
- is a career-based educational program.
- starts with the Freshman class of 2018 with an expected completion date of 2022.
- is aligned with the Profile of the SC Graduate.

The SC High School Credential will provide a course of study designed to equip students with the skills, knowledge, and work ethic needed to succeed in today's job market. Middle-skill jobs, which require education beyond high school but not a four-year degree, make-up the largest part of South Carolina's labor market.

## South Carolina's High School Credential:

SC has roughly 100,000 students with disabilities serviced under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA). While the majority are able to earn a State high school diploma, some are unable to complete the required coursework. The uniform, staterecognized SC High School Credential provides an alternative option for these students.
