PORTFOLIO FACTS

The portfolio will cover all 4 years of high school, beginning with 9th grade for the 2018-2019 academic year.

Development of the portfolio is embedded in the employability coursework so the student will be taught throughout the 9th grade year on how to create their personal portfolio.

Student owned! The student is responsible for the submissions in their notebook.

Students may have an electronic version as well as a notebook.

- Only for applicable students with IEPs
- Not a high school diploma
- About ½ of districts within the state already award a comparable credential though varied
- Standardized, state-recognized way to
 - Give students recognition
 - Employers documentation of skills
- Protect and ensure students are not inappropriately identified for this credential
