## Student/Employee—Isolation

Student/Employee reports any of the following symptoms with or without fever: \*Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing \*Loss of taste or smell \*New or worsening cough. If these symptoms are explainable by another condition isolation may not be necessary.

(example: shortness of breath with asthma)



Student/ Employee to wear mask if able to tolerate.

Student will isolate at school while waiting pick up by parent/guardian. Employee will isolate if unable to leave building immediately. Call 911 for life threatening symptoms.



Staff person to monitor until parent/guardian pick-up.
Staff may monitor student through door window. If staff must enter isolation room, maintain social distancing, wear mask, and face shield. Escort student to front door when parent/guardian arrives for pick up.



Staff monitoring isolation room is to notify custodial staff that room has been used. Per CDC wait 24 hours before cleaning/disinfecting. If 24 hours is not feasible, wait as long as possible.

Student/Employee with temperature of 100.4 or greater.



If fever lasts greater than 24 hours or without a known cause may require negative COVID-19 testing or completion of COVID-19 exclusion.

Student/Employee will be sent home per SC DHEC Criteria. (See COVID-19 flow chart)
Parent/Student or Staff will be encouraged to see healthcare provider.
